## THE NEW ROYAL PIER & WATERFRONT

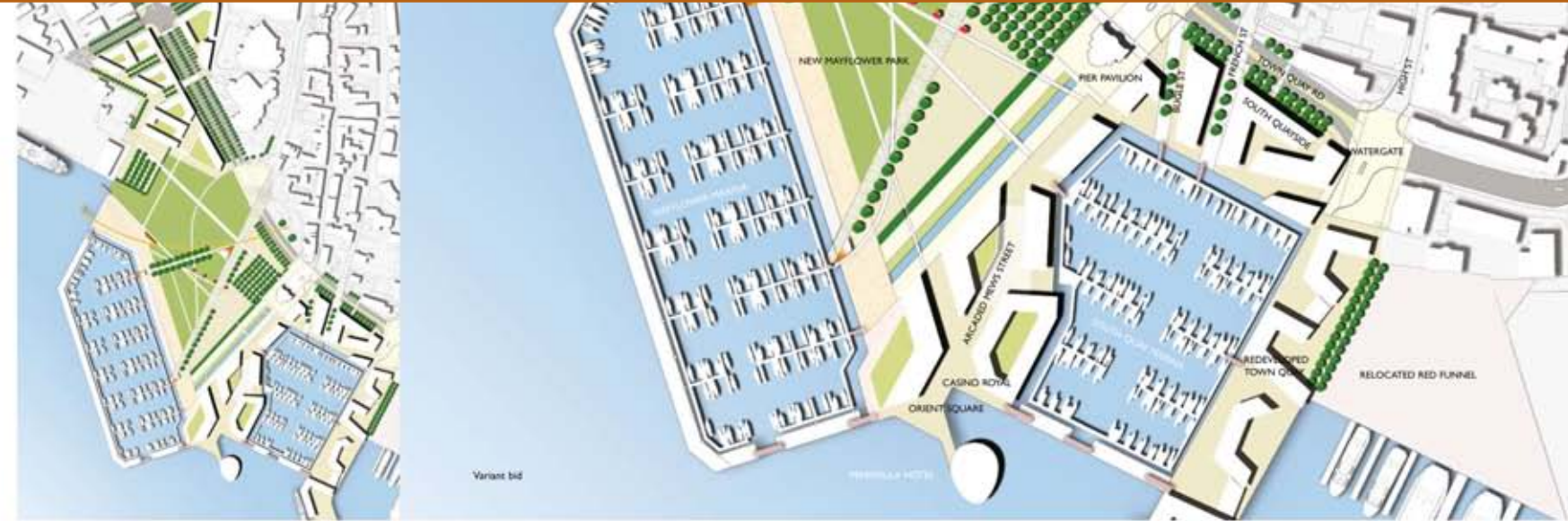
A new Royal Pier recalling the outline of the original creates a dynamic new urban quarter for the city. New specialty retail, offices, bars and restaurants of the world create a unique world class waterside destination that reflects Southampton's rich cultural diversity and importance as an international centre of trade.

A sophisticated new 'Casino Royal' sits alongside the new iconic luxury Peninsula Hotel, in a new social destination, the Orient Square at the southern tip of the new pier. It will be a perfect location to relax, unwind and enjoy the historic ships moored alongside and the most exciting point to view the huge cruise liners as they depart the port in the early evening on their way to far flung destinations.

The existing pavilion sits as the proud gateway to this new city quarter, park and waterside. A new piazza reinstates an appropriate setting for this historic building that once again reunites itself to the old town. A new water feature to the south reaches out from the pavilion to the waterside and spiritually recreates the separation between the New Royal Pier and enlarged park.

Following the relocation of Red Funnel to Dock Gate 5, the new mixed use South Quayside development and marina completes the linkage back to Town Quay - a lively water arena that links seamlessly back to Bugle Street and French Street within the Old Town.

Terraces view out over the parkland to the west and lively colonnades focus on the new South Quay marina to the east. A central arcaded mews street with ground floor specialty retail opportunities meanders through the pier, linking the historic pavilion with the activity within Orient Square and the glamorous new Peninsula Hotel.







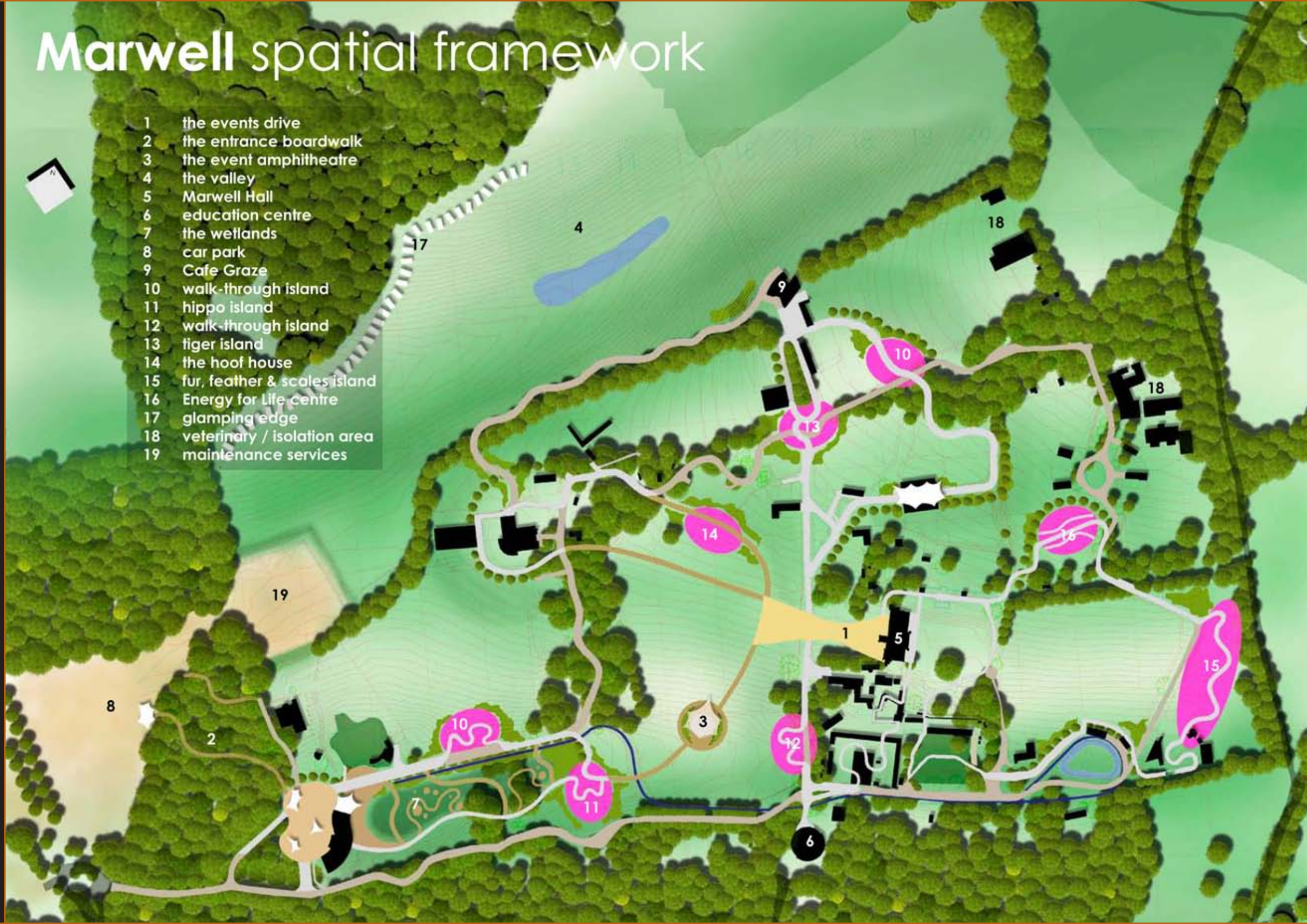
